 One gallon of used motor oil can contaminate 1 million gallons of water

 Electronic equipment that is thrown away is the fastest growing type of waste in the U.S.

 In Wisconsin there are currently 11,000 businesses, schools & government institutions that generate varying quantities & types of hazardous waste.

 In 2006 over 100 million cell phones were thrown away and 163,420 TVs and computers became obsolete every day

 E-Waste contains many valuable, recoverable materials such as aluminum, copper, gold, silver, plastics, and ferrous metals

 The average U.S. household generates up to 20 pounds of household hazardous waste per year

VERY SMALL QUANTITY GENERATOR (VSQG)

Hundreds of area businesses qualify as Very Small Quantity Generators (VSQGs). These businesses benefit financially from using the Brown County Hazardous Waste Facility.



Does your business experience the same benefits as over 300 offices, shops and manufacturers already do each year? DO YOU WANT TO?

If your company generates less than 220 pounds of hazardous waste per month and/or accumulates less than 2,205 pounds on site—you may be a VSQG!

The Brown County Hazardous Waste Facility can help your business properly and economically dispose of hazardous waste and other hazardous materials your company may generate.

Every VSQG delivery receives a Statement of Use as proof that your hazardous material was handled in a safe manner and disposed of properly.

ACCEPTED MATERIAL

Materials that are accepted from VSQGs include waste that is either listed in Wisconsin Administrative Code NR 605.09 or characteristic hazardous waste that contain traits of being:



Property and facility maintenance. Changing light bulbs. Replacing outdated electronic items. Janitorial services. All of these activities produce hazardous waste that will need to be disposed of properly.

- Chemicals
- Paint & Stains
- Solvents
- Gas & Oil
- Antifreeze
- Ballasts



Universal wastes that would be accepted include:

- Electronics
- Light bulbs
- Batteries
- Mercury & Mercury Devices
