

**TOWN OF EATON
MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 2, 2006**

Chairman Irv Saharsky called the Town Board Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

PRESENT- Town Board: Irv Saharsky, Ron DeGrand, Jim Osterloh
Others-Merle Kulhanek (zoning administrator) Dawn Konop (treasurer) Ann Potts (clerk)

MINUTES- Motion by Ron DeGrand, second by Jim Osterloh to accept minutes from September 8, 2006 Town Board Meeting. M/C.

TREASURER'S REPORT- Checking account \$5,017.17 Money market \$2,174.53
Balance on hand \$7,991.70. Motion by Ron DeGrand, second by Jim Osterloh to accept treasurer's report. M/C.

ZONING ADMINISTRATORS REPORT- Michelle Kumbalek needs her pond inspected by the town so she can receive her retainer fee.

SUZANNE KOSS- Regarding the industrial waste spreading. She presented to the Town Board with information about other towns and their ordinances. The decisions are still made by the DNR. Motion was made by Ron DeGrand and second by Jim Osterloh to open the Board Meeting to the floor to let Brown County Representative Norbert Dantinne talk and also stated that it is not a decision that can be made by the towns but by the DNR. An environmental representative by the name of John Paul from the Brown County Health Department also stated their position that if there are any problems that they may be contacted and would check out the complaint, and handed out their Code and that if anyone wanted a copy it would be made available. Motion was made by Ron DeGrand and second by Jim Osterloh to close to the floor and return to regular business. M/C.

NORMA GEZELLA- Regarding outside wood burners. Wanted to know if the town had an ordinance on wood burners, which the Town Board stated there is not an ordinance. If there was more concern, they would consider a discussion to possibly adopting an ordinance. The Town Board would need to be contacted if such a request was to be made.

KURT DEKEYSER- Water problem in the ditch on Keweaton Lane. Wants a culvert put in a driveway south of him, stating that because there is no culvert existing in that driveway is why there is water standing in his ditch. The Town Board has a water management plan that they received from the county which shows that the water should travel north, so at some point that ditch must have been filled in and the water cannot run to the north as the plan states. The Town Board is reluctant in going against what the County supplied them with and decided that they would have the land owner put in a culvert in the existing driveway.

MUNICIPAL COURT ORDINANCE- Motion to adopt Municipal Court Ordinance was made by Jim Osterloh and second by Ron DeGrand.

BUDGET 2007- The Town Board discussed the budget for 2007, and set a date for a Budget meeting for November 15 at 7:30 p.m.

APPROVE DISBURSEMENTS AND PAY BILLS- Motion by Ron DeGrand, second by Jim Osterloh to approve checks 12533 through 12562. M/C.
